| 1 | Stutts House of Barbeque | Tulsa | OK | <u>Sustain an existing business</u> -- Bring restaurant up to code, by replacing obsolete range exhaust hood at this BBQ restaurant located in Tusla's historic Greenwood District |
| 2 | Roxy Theatre | Holbrook | AZ | <u>Sustain an existing business</u> -- Complete needed repairs to cracked cement flooring and leaking roof at the last operating theater located on Route 66 in Arizona. |
| 3 | California Route 66 Museum | Victorville | CA | <u>Sustain an existing attraction</u> --Complete construction of a 1950's Diner exhibit to be built at the California Route 66 Museum. |
| 4 | Rosie the Riveter on Route 66 Documentary Film Project | Encino | CA | <u>Sustain an existing business</u> -- Fund production costs for new documentary film that will tell the story of the women who worked as "Rosie the Riveters" along Route 66. |
| 5 | Rigby House Café | Waynesville | MO | <u>Help start a new business</u> -- Exterior enhancements made to the Rigsby House cafe including flower boxes, café tables, as well as installation of custom period booths in the interior dining room. |
| 6 | Urban Art Gallery & Gift Shop | Carl Junction | MO | <u>Sustain an existing business</u> --"Rebranding & Rebooting" of Urban Art Gallery & Gift Shop, including new signage, business cards, gift bags, repairs to wooden flooring. |
| 7 | Rosati Winery Museum | St. James | MO | <u>Help start a new business</u> -- Repair restrooms in a recently purchased winery along Route 66, as well as fund improvement needed to make facility ADA compliant. |
| 8 | Flamenco Works | Albuquerque | NM | <u>Help sustain a not-for-profit</u> along Route 66 by creating a marketing plan and purchasing promotional materials designed to engage more youth and families in Flamenco Works mission. |
| 9 | Blue Swallow Motel | Tucumcari | NM | <u>Help sustain a business</u> -- Contribute to the repair of original neon damaged by a hail storm at this iconic Route 66 motel property |
| 10 | Neon Queen | Oklahoma City | OK | <u>Help sustain a business</u> -- Replace neon glass bending equipment to allow the Neon Queen business to train new neon artists. |
